Mar 11 – 12 ~ Explore Ceylon Tea Trails

You will traverse the lovely hills of Hatton and arrive at Ceylon Tea Trails just in time for a sumptuous lunch. The agenda for your stay here is purposefully flexible so that you can enjoy your surroundings at leisure. You may choose from taking guided scenic hikes, mountain biking, kayaking in the Castlereagh Reservoir, or playing tennis or croquet.

On your second afternoon, you will take a guided tour of the Dunkeld Tea Factory which looks back at the early days of tea in Sri Lanka including the lifestyle of the early colonial settlers and the manufacturing process that turns ‘two leaves and a bud’ into a delicious cup of goodness.
