EXTENSION OVERVIEW

You will spend two and a half days exploring **Kangaroo Island**, a sanctuary for wildlife off the eastern coast of South Australia. The island is known for its diverse and stunning geography, featuring rugged coastlines, pristine sandy beaches, rolling farmlands, and untouched wilderness. This extension will allow you to immerse yourself in stunning coastal landscapes and opportunities for sightings and photography of its unique wildlife, including **koalas** (introduced), **Tammar wallabies**, **Australian sea lions**, and rare endemic birds like the **Glossy Black Cockatoo**. Its isolation and conservation efforts have preserved much of Kangaroo Island's natural beauty and ecological diversity. You will explore conservation parks, sandy beaches, and historic sites.

From spotting Tasmanian devils, wombats, and endemic birds to cruising Bruny Island’s waters and birdwatching in Lamington National Park, this trip offers an immersive experience and deep connection to Australia’s diverse ecosystems.

DETAILED ITINERARY

September 22 – 24 ~ Depart from home and travel to Adelaide

Travel to Adelaide from your home airport and make your way to the hotel to relax and unwind.

September 25 ~ Travel to Kangaroo Island

Travel to **Kangaroo Island** from Adelaide on a morning flight and begin exploring the island. Ease into the relaxed rhythm of Kangaroo Island, where locals wave as they pass, and sometimes stop for a friendly chat. After your arrival, you will set out on foot along a quiet country track lined with towering eucalyptus trees. Keep your eyes peeled for snoozing **koalas** nestled in the branches, occasionally stirring to feed, and listen for the chorus of the bush—**honeyeaters**, colorful parrots, cicadas, or perhaps the peaceful sound of silence.

Continue your journey through some of the island's most fertile farmland as you make your way toward the rugged and **wildlife-rich north coast**. Accompanied by your expert guide, walk through native bushland filled with unusual tree forms and signs of wildlife. Along the way, you may spot **Tammar wallabies**, once nearly extinct on the mainland, the **Kangaroo Island kangaroo**, and a variety of native birds, plants, and insects found nowhere else.

Pause midday for a relaxed lunch at a private bush camp, enjoying local island sea and farm to table fare. Later, visit Seal Bay Conservation Park for a private, guided walk among a colony of Australian sea lions lounging along a pristine sandy beach. Witness playful pups splashing in the surf, observe powerful bulls marked from past battles, and gain insight into their unique breeding biology.

September 26 – 27 ~ Explore Kangaroo Island

Spend two immersive days discovering the diverse landscapes and wildlife of **Kangaroo Island**, from the regenerating bushlands of **Flinders Chase National Park** to the windswept headlands of the **Dudley Peninsula**. Explore iconic natural landmarks like Remarkable Rocks and Admirals Arch, home to a lively colony of **Long-nosed fur seals**, while learning about the island's unique fire ecology and the resilience of its native flora. During your stay, you will search for **koalas** (which have been introduced to the island) and visit Baudin Conservation Park which is home to **tammar wallaby** (a species almost extinct on the adjoining mainland) and **Kangaroo Island kangaroo** (a subspecies of Western Grey Kangaroo that only occurs here). You will also visit a beautiful sandy beach to see **Australian sea lions**, watch their pups nursing or playing in the surf, see old bulls bearing the scars of territorial disputes, and learn about their unique breeding biology. You'll enjoy wonderful elegant picnic lunches on both days. The island is also home to a range of rare birds, including **Cape Barren Goose** and **Glossy Black Cockatoo**. Your accommodation is near a known black cockatoo roost, which will maximize our chances of seeing this beautiful endangered species.

September 28 ~ Depart Kangaroo Island and Travel to Hobart

This morning, you will have breakfast at your accommodation, and then depart Kangaroo Island for Hobart to continue on our [Southern Australia September 2026 trip](#).

Cancellations

Until the Final Payment due date, deposits are refundable except for a cancellation fee of \$150 per person, which can be applied toward another trip if reserved within six months of the cancelled trip's departure date. Cancellations are non-transferrable. No refunds are given after the Final Payment due date.

Included

- Carbon offsets for the duration of this trip.
- All leaders, transport, park entry fees, landing fees, and permits for all activities unless described as optional.
- Accommodations (double occupancy) for the nights of September 24 through 28.
- Meals from breakfast on September 25 through breakfast on September 28.
- Transfer on September 25 from Kingscote Airport to Aurora Ozone Hotel.
- Transfer on September 28 between Aurora Ozone Hotel and Kingscote Airport.

Not Included

- Carbon offsets for your flights to/from this trip.
- All airfare, airport and departure taxes, and excess baggage fees. Round-trip airfare is approximately \$1,450 to \$1,600 between the US and Hobart, Australia, and back to the US from Adelaide, depending on origin. The one-way flight between Adelaide and Kangaroo Island and the one-way flight between Kangaroo Island and Hobart will be added to your trip balance based on rates at the time of booking. The estimated cost is \$500-600.
- Passport and visa fees.
- Divergent airport transfers (arranged by us) and extra hotel nights.
- Transfer on September 24 from Adelaide Airport to your accommodation.
- Transfer on September 25 from your accommodation to Adelaide Airport.
- Gratuities – tipping is not required or expected in Australia and prices usually include goods and services tax (GST) which is equivalent to VAT. However, if you feel that your guides, a staff member, or any service provider has done an outstanding job or exceeded your expectations, it is appropriate to give them a tip in appreciation. A recommended amount is approximately 10% of a meal/service charge and AU\$10-20 per day for a tour guide.

- Items of a personal nature such as laundry, telephone calls, medical costs or hospitalization, room

service, alcoholic and other beverages, items not on the regular menu, etc. If you have special dietary needs, please indicate them on your Traveler Form.
